Make a Palm Cross Make a Palm Cross You will need : 1 A4 sheet of thin yellow card, (this will make 7 palm crosses), ruler, pencil, a pair of scissors. Cut the card into strips 1.5cms wide and 29.6cms long. You will need 2 of these strips for each palm cross. To make the crossbeam of the palm cross: On one of the strips mark from the left

Now turn the cross over and take the vertical end of the cross and gently slip it through the pocket slit from the back. Leave as much of it on top as you would like and adjust the remaining through the slit to form the foot of the cross. And there you have it, your paper Palm Cross is ready!

Materials needed to make the Palm Cross. A long strip of palm or paper; about 14 inches is fine. The process of making the palm cross is quite easy. The first part involves making a knot that will become the center of the Easter cross. Then the side and top shorter arms, and lastly the longer arm.

1. Take a palm frond about 1/2 inch wide and 13 inches and hold upright 2. Fold the top down, away from you, and the bottom up, away from you, to form the shaft of a cross of desired length 3. Turn the end down and twist around to the right and across the front of the shaft to make a crossbar in proportion to the length. 4.

Start by painting the paper plate and set it aside to dry completely. Download the cross template (find it at the end of the article), cut out the cross and trace it in the middle of the painted paper plate. Use a craft knife to cut out the cross. (This is an adult only step) Use a hole punch to make holes along the four ends of the cross.
